STATEMENT ON PRIVACY AND PERSONAL DATA HANDLING ART 13, D.L. 196/2003

» Collection of information and subscription to services

As the subject entitled to handle data collected at registration, voluntarily or automatically by services supplied and offered on its Website 1001holidayhouses.com or partner sites, 1001s.r.l. informs you that your personal data, with your consent, will be used to provide the services you requested and to create customer profiles for focused promotional campaigns. To cancel the subscription to the email service please follow the instructions you will find at end of each message. 1001 s.r.l. will not try to collect "sensitive data" (health, religion, etc.), and in case of accidental collection will not transfer it to other subjects. We should like to remind you that your personal data is always given to 1001s.r.l. under your responsibility. Additional personal information, though not mandatory, will help us tailor our offer to better meet your requirements (new services, commercial promotions, etc.)

» E-mail service subscription procedure (double opt-in)

Each new subscription is double checked by 1001 s.r.l. through a system requiring you to confirm your subscription (double opt-in), this is to ascertain that the person subscribing actually is the holder of the email address submitted.

»Correction/Updating of personal data

In accordance to the Legislative Decree 196/2003, article 7, we inform you that you have the following rights:

"Art. 7. Right of access to personal data and other rights".

1. The individual has the right to receive confirmation of the existence or not of personal data regarding him, even if not yet registered, and communication of the same in intelligible form.
2. The individual has the right to receive the indication of the origin of his personal data; of the purposes for and conditions in which said data is to be handled; of the logic applied in the case of treatment performed with electronic systems; of the identity of the controller, the processors and the representative appointed under the terms of article 5, subsection 2; of the subjects or subject categories to which personal data may be communicated or that may receive such information while acting as national territory representatives, processors or appointees.
3. The individual has the right to obtain: updates, modifications, or, if so desired, integrations of data; deletion, transformation into anonymous format, or blocking of data unlawfully processed, including data the retention of which is not necessary for the purposes for which it was collected or subsequently processed; a formal statement that the above operations have been notified, also with regard to their contents, to whomever the data was released to, unless the fulfilment of this requirement proves impossible or involves a disproportionate effort with respect to the right being protected.
4. The individual has the right to object, wholly or in part: on legitimate grounds to the processing of his/her personal data even though such data is relevant to the purpose of its collection; to the processing of his/her personal data for the submission of advertising or direct sales material or for market researches or commercial communications.
